Abstract

With an increase of bioterrorism and mass casualty incidents (MCIs), emergency department personnel are not adequately equipped and supported to respond to such incidents. This

project aims to increase leadership support to frontline staff by implementing Prosci's Change

Management Process to equip management with the necessary skills to support their staff

through a new protocol implementation for MCIs. This project included an implementation of

an MCI protocol into the Emergency Department (ED) in which ED personnel participated in a

mock code to demonstrate the new protocol in case of an MCI. The ED staff participated in a

quality improvement questionnaire that determined the leadership support was increased

during this project timeline.
