



  - Understand concerns







  - Mobilization, culture, language, advocacy, sense of belonging, trust, empowerment, culture competence






#### **Background & Significance**

- Author's personal experience






#### Problem/Population, Intervention, Comparison, Outcome (PICO)

In Nigerian immigrant women of childbearing age living in the United States, does educational intervention on the use of epidural analgesia during labor increase the willingness of the women to accept it during labor?






#### **Evidence synthesis**

- Effect of maternal country of birth and epidural use
  - ☐ Reduced odds for women of sub-Saharan descent
- Nigerian parturient & epidural labor analgesia
  - Grounded in culture, ethics, religion, acceptance of pain, lack of knowledge, cost, discouragement, fear, language barrier, stigma, lack of culturally competence providers, biased providers, lack of trust






#### **Evidence Synthesis Contd...**


- Best practices in labor analgesia
  - Neuraxial analgesia considered gold standard
- ➤ Shared decision making (SDM)
  - ☐ Partners preference and epidural use
- > Best implementation strategies
  - ☐ Preferred spoken language and neuraxial analgesia utilization

The Health Belief Model




- ➤ Health Belief Model (HBM)
  - ☐ Discernment of threat and value associated with actions to reduce threat (Polit & Beck, 2020)






Demographics (23 participants)

...of a Nigerian heritage. ...of a childbearing age
















## Post Education Effects After Watching DNP Video








#### Strengths of the Project

- ✓ Hands-on / Community-based






### **Limitations of the Project**

- ✓ Lack of previous research






